ARTICLE 1: To elect four (4) school directors from the nominees to serve on the school board of the Windham Southeast School District from the date of the election:

Two (2) school directors (one from each town) who are residents of Guilford and Putney for a three-year term.

ARTICLES

ARTICLE 3: Shall the voters of the school district authorize compensation in the total amount of \$42,000 to the district board, which is the amount of \$4,000 for each director, and that the chair shall receive an additional \$2,000?

ARTICLE 4: Shall the voters of the school district authorize the school board to expend \$52,103,190 which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$19,432 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 2.6% higher than spending for the current year.
